	Blue Rock. Climb rock to forest walk, through rehabilitated bauxite mine

	Historic cemetery, then through rare virgin forest. Medium difficulty	
Sun 7 Aug	KITTY'S TRACK – VIEWS	5 or 12km
	Both tracks have steep sections by Gooralong Brook	
Sun 28 Aug M	ROUND THE BRIDGES and GOLDEN WATTLES	5km
	Easy flat saunter over bridges, through developing Heritage Park	
Sun 18 Sept	FLOWERS AND VIEWS TO DIE FOR	4 or 6km
	Choice of easy 4km or steep 6km. Flowers and views on both walks	
Sun 16 Oct	BLOOMING ROCKS	4 or 8km
	Stunning verticordias and forest orchids on medium walks
